Standing Up for Sporting and the Outdoors

Pennsylvania has a long and proud history of hunting, fishing and outdoor recreation. According to the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service and U.S. Census Bureau, in 2011 4.6 million residents and visitors enjoyed outdoor activities and spent \$2.8 billion in Pennsylvania.

His business, like many in Pennsylvania, used to close the first day of hunting season. - **Protect the rights of gun owners, hunters and anglers** – Our sportsmen and women have played a major role in shaping our outdoor recreation sector and protecting our natural habitats. Wolf will work to make sure licenses and other fees are priced appropriately and key stakeholders have a voice in all relevant policy decisions. Tom Wolf knows Pennsylvania has a long history of responsible gun ownership, and he will continue to protect the Second Amendment right of residents to own firearms.



- **Support the work of the Pennsylvania Game Commission and the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission** – These two Commissions are essential to maintaining a thriving outdoor recreation sector. Tom Wolf will appoint qualified commissioners, support their important work and make sure they have the resources to operate efficiently and effectively.
- **Promote environmentally sound policies** – Wolf will work with hunters, anglers and outdoor enthusiasts to implement policies that maintain our clean water and air, and expand preservation and conservation efforts. Wolf will launch a Growing Greener III initiative, reinstate the moratorium on drilling in state parks and forests and oppose special interest legislation like the recent attempt to amend our endangered species act.
- **Strengthen outdoor tourism sector** – Tom Wolf knows we can do a better job of marketing our scenic spaces, which will allow us to invest more in conservation and environmental protection. Wolf will work to improve our hunting, fishing and boating infrastructure, and he will proudly take on the role of the state's top spokesperson for Pennsylvania's outdoor recreation activities.
